Material Guidelines

- Advertisements must be supplied as Apple Mac-compatible programs – InDesign, Photoshop or Adobe Acrobat.
- Advertisements must be supplied on a readable disk – Zip, CD, or by email or via Dropbox.
- Please supply original illustrations, photos and business logos, as high resolution images or hard copy for advertisement to be made up. Layout available with a flat fee of AU\$65 per hour.
- Hi-res Pdfs must be supplied with all fonts embedded, images specified as CMYK, and appropriate bleed allowed.
- Rates are based on the understanding that all material is supplied according to our material requirements listed.
- Allow 5mm bleed all round on Full page or Double page ad where required.

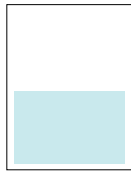
